COURT ORDER REQUIREMENTS

THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS HAS BEEN UNDER A FEDERAL COURT ORDER SINCE 2001. THE COURT REQUIREMENTS: CONSOLIDATE OPERATIONS, STAFF TRAINING ON MENTAL HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH SCREENING, ASSESS BEHAVIORAL RISK, PROVIDE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, AND PROVIDE PROGRAMMING FOR INMATES.

STATE INITIATIVES

ELDERLY OR INFIRMED INMATES

THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS DEFINES ELDERLY INMATES AS ALL THOSE AGED 50 YEARS AND OLDER. FLORIDA DOES NOT SEGREGATE COSTS FOR THE CUSTODY AND CARE OF ELDERLY OR INFIRMED INMATES. AS OF JULY 2005, ELDERLY INMATES WHO DO NOT HAVE SPECIAL NEEDS CAN BE ASSIGNED TO ANY ADULT INSTITUTION; HOWEVER, THOSE WITH SPECIAL NEEDS ARE ASSIGNED TO FOUR CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES - RIVER JUNCTION WORK CAMP (353 INMATES), UNION CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION (2,050 INMATES), ZEPHYRHILLS CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION (691 INMATES), AND SOUTH FLORIDA RECEPTION CENTER SOUTH UNIT (564 INMATES).

PRISON BASED SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAMS

ON JULY 1, 2000, THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS IMPLEMENTED MANDATORY SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM PARTICIPATION FOR INMATES MEETING SELECT CRITERIA. AN AUTOMATED SCREENING AND PRIORITY PLACEMENT SYSTEM WAS IMPLEMENTED TO IDENTIFY INMATES MEETING THE CRITERIA FOR THE PROGRAM AND TO PRIORITIZE THEM BASED ON RISK TO PUBLIC SAFETY AND SEVERITY OF ADDICTION. \$7.2 MILLION, OF WHICH \$2.8 MILLION IN STATE FUNDS, WAS SPENT FOR CONTRACTED SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM SERVICES AT PUBLIC FACILITIES.

PRISON BASED SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAMS

FLORIDA'S SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAMS OFFERED:

- PREVENTION PROGRAMMING (TIER 1 - 1 LOCATION): VOLUNTARY SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM FOR ADULT AND YOUTHFUL OFFENDER FEMALE INMATES.
- INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAMMING (MODALITY 1 - 20 LOCATIONS): 4-6 MONTH OUTPATIENT, (W/IN PRISON SETTING) PROGRAM AT DESIGNED INSTITUTIONS FOR 1/2 DAY AT LEAST 4 DAYS A WEEK WITH A MINIMUM OF 12 HOURS OF COUNSELOR-SUPERVISED ACTIVITIES.
- RESIDENTIAL THERAPEUTIC COMMUNITY (MODALITY 2 - 6 LOCATIONS): 9-12 MONTH PROGRAM HOUSED WITHIN INSTITUTION OR A DESIGNATED COMMUNITY-BASED FACILITY.
- PROGRAM CENTER (CONTINUUM OF SERVICES - 3 LOCATIONS): MODIFIED THERAPEUTIC COMMUNITY TO PROVIDE PREVENTION, OUTPATIENT, AND AFTERCARE SERVICES, AS WELL AS EDUCATION/VOCATIONAL SERVICES.

PRE-RELEASE/POST-RELEASE ("REENTRY") PROGRAMS



THE FLORIDA DOC DOES HAVE PRE-RELEASE PROGRAMS AND PROVIDES POST-RELEASE ASSISTANCE FOR INMATES TO FACILITATE A SMOOTH TRANSITION FROM PRISON TO THE COMMUNITY. THE BUREAU OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM SERVICES CONTRACTS WITH FAITH-BASED ORGANIZATIONS IN THE COMMUNITY FOR THE PROVISION OF THE PROGRAMS. TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAMS EXIST TO ASSIST NEWLY RELEASED INMATES IN THEIR TRANSITION FROM INSTITUTION TO THE COMMUNITY BY OFFERING A STRUCTURED AND SUPPORTIVE ENVIRONMENT.

1. 100-HOUR TRANSITION PROGRAM IS A STATUTORILY MANDATED COMPREHENSIVE TRANSITION PROGRAM THAT COVERS JOB READINESS AND LIFE MANAGEMENT SKILLS. THIS TRAINING IS PROVIDED TO ALL INMATES WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF THEIR RELEASE FROM A FLORIDA PRISON.
2. SERIOUS AND VIOLENT OFFENDER REENTRY INITIATIVE PROGRAM (PROJECT GOING HOME) IS INTENDED TO REDUCE RECIDIVISM, INCREASE SAFETY, AND INTEGRATE OFFENDERS.
3. A FEDERAL GRANT (SPECTER GRANTS FOR YOUTHFUL OFFENDERS PROGRAM) THAT PROVIDES POST-SECONDARY VOCATIONAL TRAINING FOR YOUTHFUL OFFENDERS 25 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER THROUGH PRIVATE CONTRACTORS AND ACCREDITED POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS.
4. PROJECT RECONNECT SELECTS INMATES TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE UPON RELEASE WITH EMPLOYMENT AND LINKAGES TO COMMUNITY RESOURCES TO HELP THEM EASE THE TRANSITION FROM PRISON TO THE COMMUNITY. PROJECT RECONNECT CONDUCTS JOB FAIRS AND CAREER EXPLORATION SEMINARS AROUND THE STATE.

5. ESUBA (ABUSE SPELLED BACKWARDS) IS WOMEN HELPING WOMEN TURN ABUSE AROUND.
 6. KEN COOPER MINISTRIES IS A 13 WEEK PROGRAM FOCUSING ON SUBSTANCE ABUSE EDUCATION FOR UP TO 200 INMATES.
 7. DADS (DADS ACTIVELY DEVELOPING STABLE FAMILIES) IS A SIX WEEK PROGRAM THAT STRESSES THE IMPORTANT ROLE FATHERS PLAY IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF CHILDREN.
 8. FLORIDA INNOVATION MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ESTABLISHES A COOPERATIVE RELATIONSHIP WITH WORKFORCE BOARDS AND ONE-STOP CENTERS TO FACILITATE JOB PLACEMENTS AND REFERRALS FOR ALL EX-OFFENDERS.
 9. THE FAITH BASED DORMITORY PROGRAM IS A 12-MONTH VOLUNTARY PROGRAM THAT SEEKS TO UNITE CORRECTIONS AND THE FAITH COMMUNITY TO EFFECT AN INNER TRANSFORMATION OF INMATES.
 10. FLORIDA SAFETY COUNCIL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT PROVIDES ADVANCE DRIVER INSTRUCTION AT SELECTED FACILITIES FOR INMATES WITH SUSPENDED, REVOKED, OR EXPIRED DRIVER'S LICENSE.
 11. BRIDGING THE GAP MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT IS A COLLABORATIVE EFFORT BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENTS OF CORRECTIONS AND JUVENILE JUSTICE, GIRLS ADVOCACY PROJECT, TO PROVIDE A 12-WEEK WRITING WORKSHOP TO ADULT FEMALE INMATES.
 12. ARTSPRING AND FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT IS A 12 TO 15 WEEK ART PROGRAM PROMOTING CREATIVITY, GROWTH, DEVELOPMENT AND SELF-EXPRESSION TO MALE AND FEMALE INMATES.
 13. OPERATION NEW HOPE PROVIDES RE-ENTRY SERVICES TO ELIGIBLE INMATES AGES 18-34, WHO HAVE BEEN SENTENCED AND SERVED TIME FOR NON-VIOLENT AND NON-SEXUAL FELONY OFFENSES.
 14. M.A.D. DADS OF GREATER OCALA (MEN AGAINST DESTRUCTION - DEFENDING AGAINST DRUGS AND SOCIAL DISORDERS) ENABLES INMATES AND EX-INMATES TO PARTICIPATE IN TRANSITION AND RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS INTENDED TO FACILITATE REENTRY INTO THE COMMUNITY.

CONCERNS WITH AGING ADULT CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES

FLORIDA HAS OVER 70 CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS WITH THEM RANGING IN AGE FROM 90 YEARS OLD TO ONLY 1 YEAR OLD.
