AS OF JUNE 30, 2006, THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS IS NOT UNDER A FEDERAL OR STATE COURT ORDER.

STATE INITIATIVES

ELDERLY OR INFIRMED INMATES

THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS ADDRESSES THE CLINICAL NEEDS OF ITS INMATE POPULATION IN AN INDIVIDUALIZED FASHION. THEREFORE, ELDERLY INMATES ARE TREATED AS PER THEIR TREATMENT PLAN, INCLUDING CHRONIC CARE GUIDELINES FOR ANY CHRONIC CONDITION AS OUTLINED IN ACA 4TH EDITION STANDARDS. THERE IS A SPECIALIZED UNIT IN THE SYSTEM THAT IS ABLE TO HOUSE THE MOST FRAIL OR CRITICALLY ILL ELDERLY INMATES. THE NURSING CARE FACILITY HOUSES INMATES IN AN ENVIRONMENT ANALOGOUS TO A NURSING HOME. INMATES PLACED IN THIS UNIT ARE PROVIDED ENHANCED NURSING SUPPORT, CLINICAL CARE AND ASSISTANCE WITH DAILY LIVING.

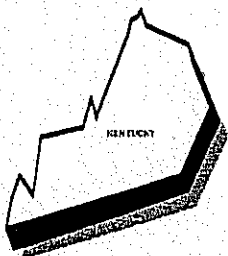
PRISON BASED SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAMS

THE STATE OF KENTUCKY, DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS CURRENTLY OPERATES SIX PRISON BASED PROGRAMS AND THREE JAIL PROGRAMS FOR THOSE STATE INMATES CLASSIFIED AS JAIL STATUS. PRISON AND JAIL PROGRAMS ARE THERAPEUTIC COMMUNITIES (TC). BY YEAR END, THERE WILL BE 8 PRISON PROGRAMS AND 8 JAIL PROGRAMS. PRISON FUNDING IS THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT BUDGET AND JAIL PROGRAMS ARE THROUGH GRANTS. THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE PROGRAMS ARE DETERMINED BY REGULAR AUDITS THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT'S DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH. RECIDIVISM RATES ARE BEING TRACKED WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY, DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH. DATA FROM ALL INMATES ENTERING SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAMS IS ENTERED INTO A DATA BASE TO BE COMPARED TO GENERAL POPULATION INMATES. THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET IS \$1.2 MILLION.

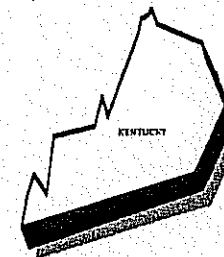

PRE-RELEASE/POST-RELEASE ("REENTRY") PROGRAMS

THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS OPERATES A PRE-RELEASE PROGRAM FOR OFFENDERS. IT IS A 10-DAY COURSE THAT IS NORMALLY CONDUCTED 90 DAYS FROM THE OFFENDER'S RELEASE DATE OR PAROLE ELIGIBILITY DATE. FUNDING IS THRU THE ADULT INSTITUTION BUDGET. KENTUCKY HAS ANOTHER PROGRAM, THE HOME INCARCERATION PROGRAM, WHERE INMATES WHO MEET CRITERIA (INMATE WITH NO SEX OR VIOLENT CHARGE) CAN ELECT TO SERVE THE REMAINING 90 DAYS OF THEIR SENTENCE OUT IN THE COMMUNITY IF THEY AGREE TO WEAR ELECTRONIC MONITORING DEVICE. THEY REPORT TO A PAROLE OFFICER. THE DEPARTMENT IS CURRENTLY WORKING ON A POST-RELEASE PROGRAM TO GIVE OFFENDERS THE ABILITY TO FIND RESOURCES ON THE OUTSIDE AFTER THEY HAVE LEFT THE SYSTEM.



CONCERNS WITH AGING ADULT CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES

KENTUCKY HAS 13 CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES WITH AN AVERAGE AGE OF 44 YEARS OLD. KENTUCKY STATE PENITENTIARY IS THE OLDEST FACILITY (122 YEARS OLD), WHILE THE NEWEST FACILITY IS LITTLE SANDY CORRECTIONAL COMPLEX AT 1 YEAR. KENTUCKY'S FACILITIES ARE WELL MAINTAINED BY IN-HOUSE STAFF. ALL PASS ACI INSPECTIONS. THE ONLY PROBLEMS ARE PREVENTIVE AND PREDICTIVE MAINTENANCE, WHICH REQUIRES SPECIAL EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, AND TRAINING.
